

## **Automatic Debit Plan**

Tithing – what does it really mean? The Internal Revenue Service allows for it, with a deduction of up to 50% of one's income for charitable giving. In Genesis 28:20-22, Jacob made a vow to the Lord that, out of all the Lord gave to him, he would give a tenth in return. This was later commanded in Deuteronomy 27:30: "A tithe of everything from the land, whether grain from the soil or fruit from the trees, belongs to the Lord; it is holy to the Lord." In fact, the Israelites were also commanded to give additional tithes for the Levites and, every three years, for the poor. The New Testament treats tithing not as a demand of the law, but as a response of love and gratitude to God for the gift of salvation through His son Jesus Christ. "Each person should give what he has decided in his heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver." II Corinthians 9:7.
